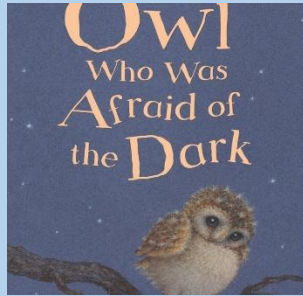


## English-The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark

## Geography
